The car museum

Get ready to be amazed as you lift the bonnet on your journey of discovery at autobau erlebniswelt. Get up close and personal with legendary sports cars, iconic classics, modern supercars and professional race cars from around the world. The unique collection belonging to Swiss racing driver and businessman Fredy Lienhard is centred around sports cars and includes around 120 vehicles in its permanent line-up. It features everything from classic grand tourers to superb sports cars and lightning-quick vehicles from the world's fastest and most spectacular race series, such as rallying and dragster racing, the legendary Le Mans Prototype (LMP) class, the famous American Indycar series and Formula 1.

Discover the cars on your own terms

During the Pitwalk opening times, all five exhibition halls, the car library, the bar in the Pitlane Lobby and the smokers' lounge are open to visitors. You choose where to start and end your experience, and where you want to spend the most time. autobau erlebniswelt is an experience for the whole family.

Dynamic exhibition

Located on the site of the old fuel depot in Romanshorn, this industrial area has been restored with a keen eye for detail and houses five exhibition halls, each with up to three floors. In the "Supersport-Galerie", the "Racing-Halle", the "Klassik-Salon" and the "Stahltank", the vehicles on display change regularly. In the "Lista Racing Box", you can experience Fredy Lienhard's racing career through a series of snapshots. Our expert autobau guides are there to assist you and answer your questions at any time.

Clay Regazzoni Honor Room

In the "Clay Regazzoni Honor Room", autobau erlebniswelt brings the story of Switzerland's most successful Formula 1 racer back to life. His former racing cars and his private vehicles, aswell as his sizeable collection of trophies and memorabilia, are opened up the general public and his fans from around the world with the Honor Room.

Bugatti Type 51 Grand Prix 1931

Since March 2022, a Bugatti from the pre-war period has added an extra touch of glamour to the collection. Fredy Lienhard described this addition as a historic moment for autobau, as none of the other vehicles on display date back further than 1950. From 1912–1933, Bugatti race cars were some of the best around. The constant need for ever-greater power in order to maintain dominance led to the creation of the Type 51 Grand Prix in 1930. This was the logical next step after the superb Type 35 generation.

Roll-out and carspotting

A roll-out or carspotting event takes place on around four Saturdays per year. At the roll-out, a vehicle from the collection is presented in detail before being taken for a spin on the autobau circuit. At carspotting events, various cars from the exhibition are parked outside and driven around the circuit. Carspotters definitely get their money's worth here. Taking photos and videos is expressly permitted at both events.
